

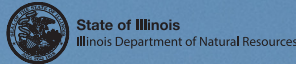
RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Alcohol is prohibited at the Campground and on our park trails. It is banned in the remainder of the park property January 1st-May 31st.
- Ground fires are not allowed but for the Youth Group Camping Area (they must be contained and not left unattended). No wood may be collected from the park's natural areas. You can purchase wood at the local camp store, 24 hours a day, or at Jacks Wood down the road.
- All pets must remain on a leash, attended to at all times, and the owner is responsible for cleaning up after their pet.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm—7 am. The campground gates lock at 10 pm and reopen at 8:30 am.
- Camping permits must be displayed on the numbered post at the campsite.
- All tents must be erected within 15 feet of the gravel pad at the campsite.
- All vehicles must park on the gravel pads (NOT the campground road). Youth Group vehicles must park in the parking lot by the Youth Group Area.
- Those individuals who violate park rules as stated above may face consequences of eviction or arrest.
- The shower houses are for the main campground users only and not for those camping in the Youth Group Area.

RESERVATIONS

- Reservations can be made 4 days to 6 months in advance through <https://camp.exploremoreil.com> unless you are requesting a Youth Group Campsite whereas you will need to contact the park at 1-815- 667-4726 (M-F, 9-4) and dial 0 for assistance.
- Walk-Ins are welcome and can pay by envelope/ drop box at the campground booth. Reservations are highly recommended. The campground reaches full capacity every May-October.
- Cancellation Policy: Reservations must be canceled (by camper-online) 4 or more days in advance of camp date to receive a full refund. There is a non-refundable transaction fee of \$5 plus a 2.2% (credit card) or \$1 (e-check) convenience fee.
- A minimum 2 night reservation is required for Memorial Day, Labor Day, and Fourth of July (when it falls on a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday).
- Camper must be 18 years old or older to camp unless accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- There is a maximum of 1 family/household (2 parents with their minor children) or 4 adults per site with 2 tents, or 1 RV and 1 tent.
- **The Youth Group Area is strictly for Youth Group Organizations! Min of 10/max of 25 per site. \$2/per person/per night or \$20 minimum.**
